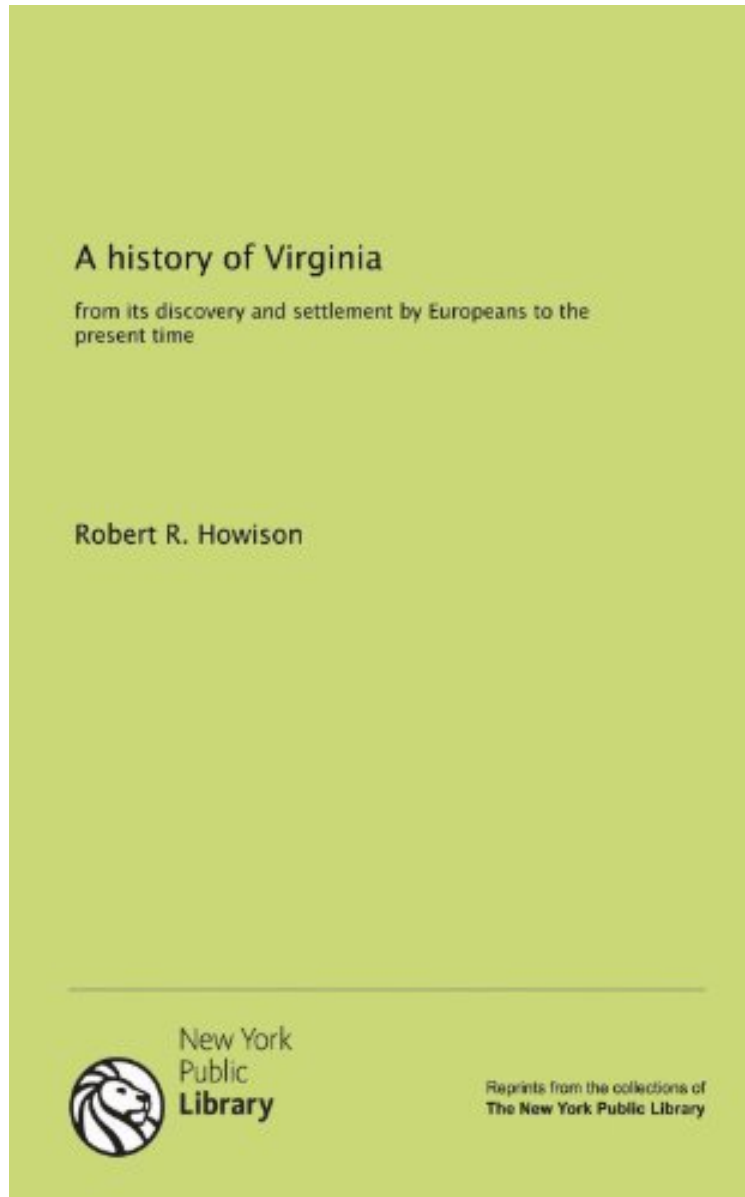

The author gives a lot of pertinent facts related to the actual settlement of Virginia. This is a history book; it is not much use as a genealogical reference. Only the names of the main characters who "inherited" or were "posted" as officials are cited. He avoids the slavery issue completely. I enjoyed this book because it is not "sugar coated". It was written in the mid 1800s. I would highly recommend this book to all. It gave me deeper understanding as to what my ancestors who came to Virginia had to endure from the "officials" as the territory grew. The lack of 5 stars is only due to the difficulty in following the manuscript with the footnotes within the text.
