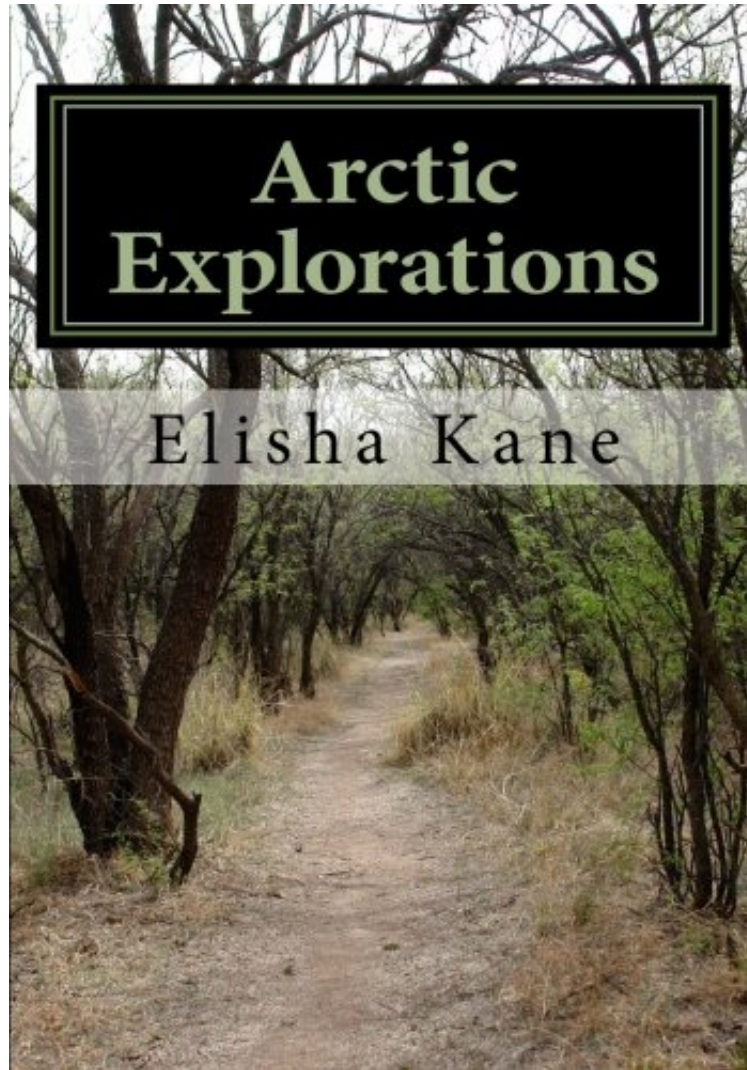

He was able to keep his crew from starving up in the Arctic ice and although he didn't find Franklin he wrote and made sketches of the areas which were so important for later explorations. He almost got to the northwest Passage but his ship was destroyed by being iced in. Kane wrote the book in the late 1850s and illustrated it

with engravings made from his sketches. The book is very readable and at times even amusing.

Elisha Kent Kane (February 28, 1820 February 16, 1857) was an American explorer, and a medical officer in the United States Navy during the first half of the 19th century. He was a member of two Arctic expeditions to rescue the explorer Sir John Franklin.
