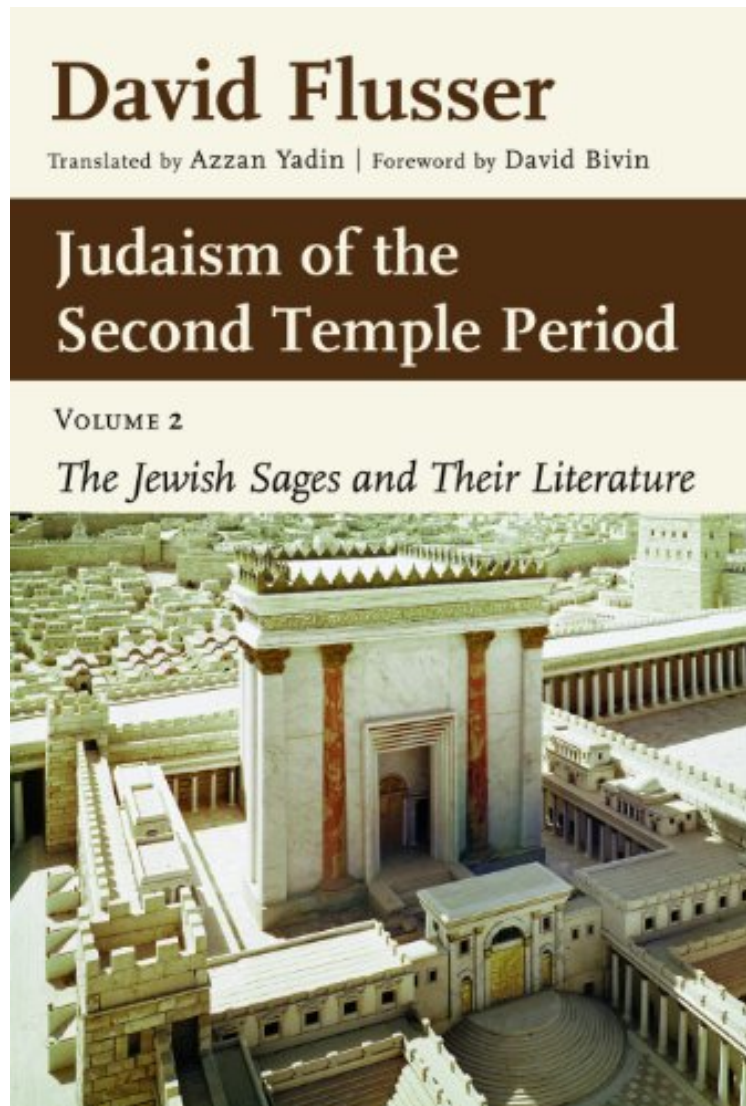

David Flusser was an incredibly prolific scholar of ancient Judaism, and his contributions to Dead Sea Scrolls research and apocalyptic literature are inestimable. This English edition makes more of Flussers insightful work available to a wider audience than ever before.

About the Author David Flusser (1917-2000) was professor of early Christianity and Second Temple Judaism at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, a member of the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities, and a recipient of the national Israel Prize in 1980 for his academic achievements. His best-known book, *Jesus*, has been translated into eleven languages and is now in its fourth edition under the title *The Sage from Galilee* (Eerdmans).
