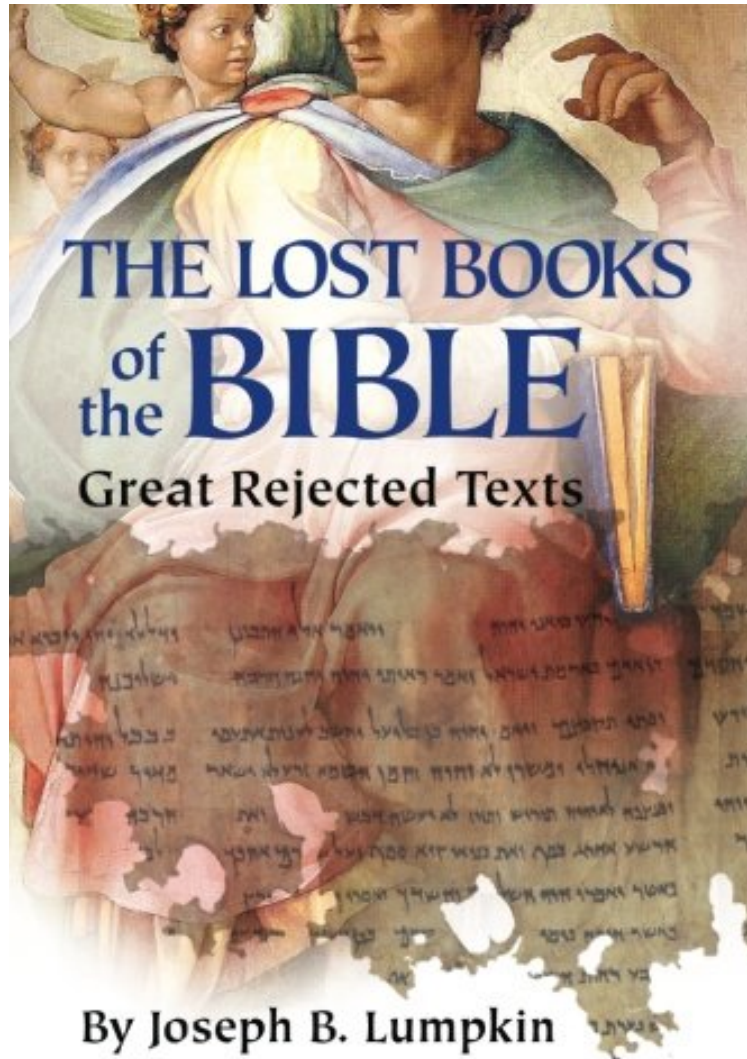

He also makes it better reading by paraphrasing some of the text and translates it into modern English to increase its readability.Each book detailed in the cover is also explained with an overview and insights into the meaning and context of these "Lost Books" before the actual translation.It is a great read for anyone wanting to learn about books that were never included in the Bible.
