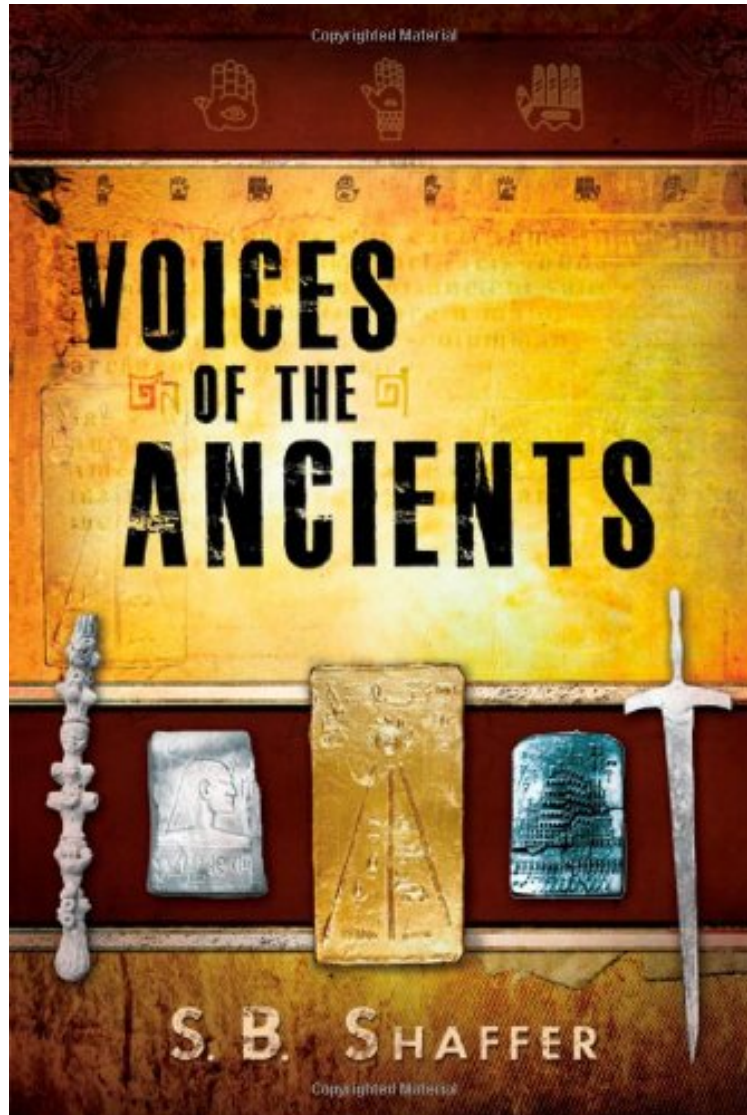

Stephen B. Shaffer's new book, *Voices of the Ancients*, brings together under one cover many of the discoveries of ancient records and sites that have been circulating for years throughout the world of those interesting in this fascinating past part of the world's history. Of particular interest to understanding many of the signs carved into rocks, trees, cave walls, on parchment and plates, is the chapter ten on numbers. Many prophecies yet to be fulfilled from the scriptures can become clearer once a person masters the information in chapter ten. Chapter eight, also, on the ancient signs and symbols of the Americas goes hand in hand with chapter ten in deciphering much of our past history. Of particular interest to the reader will be those discoveries of ancient records which show a multi-cultured past to the Americas that has yet to be fully understood and interpreted. Brewer's Cave in the Manti, Utah area is one of the great finds that has yet to be fully understood and translated. That collection has now been safely guarded for future study.
